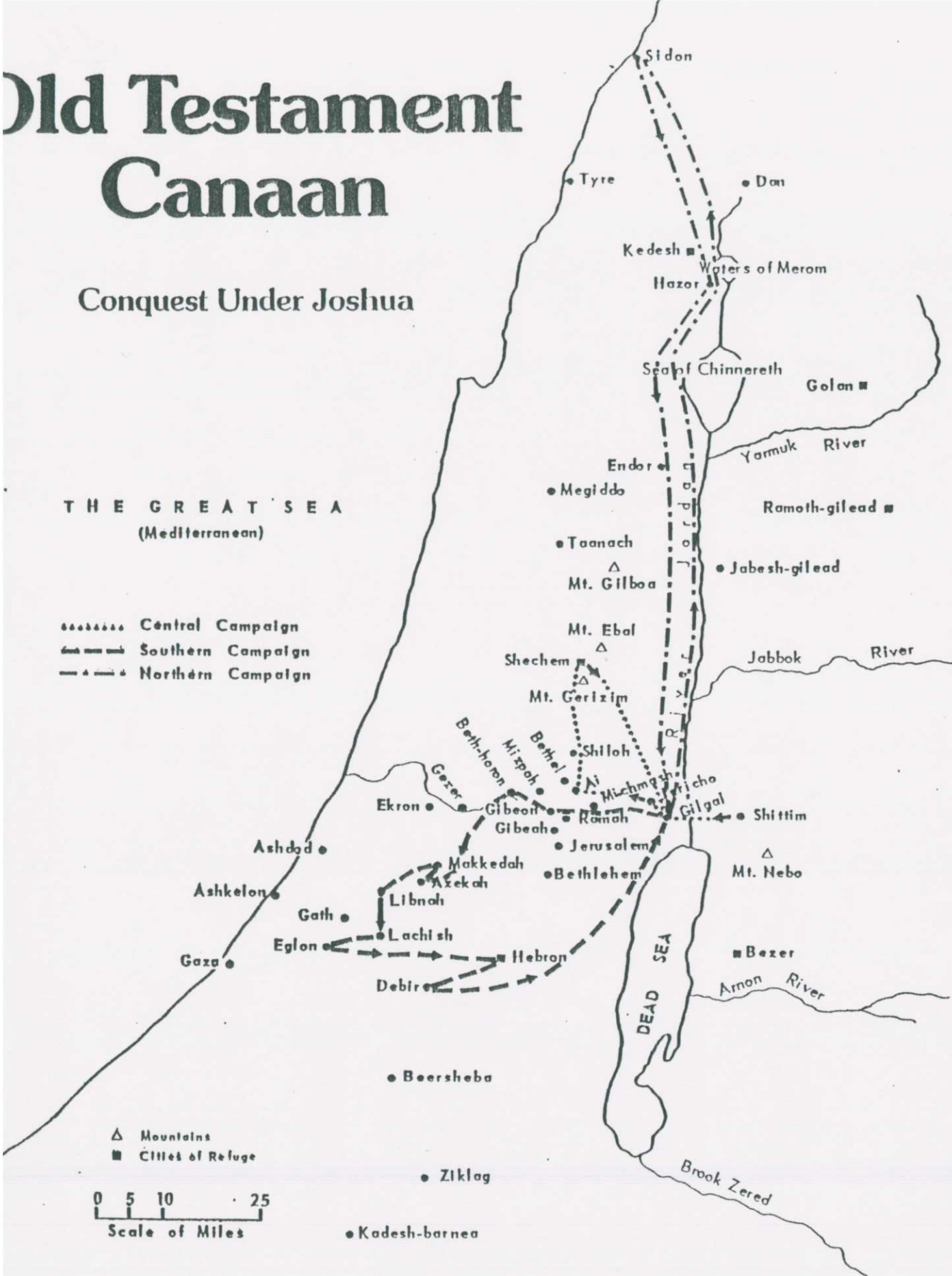

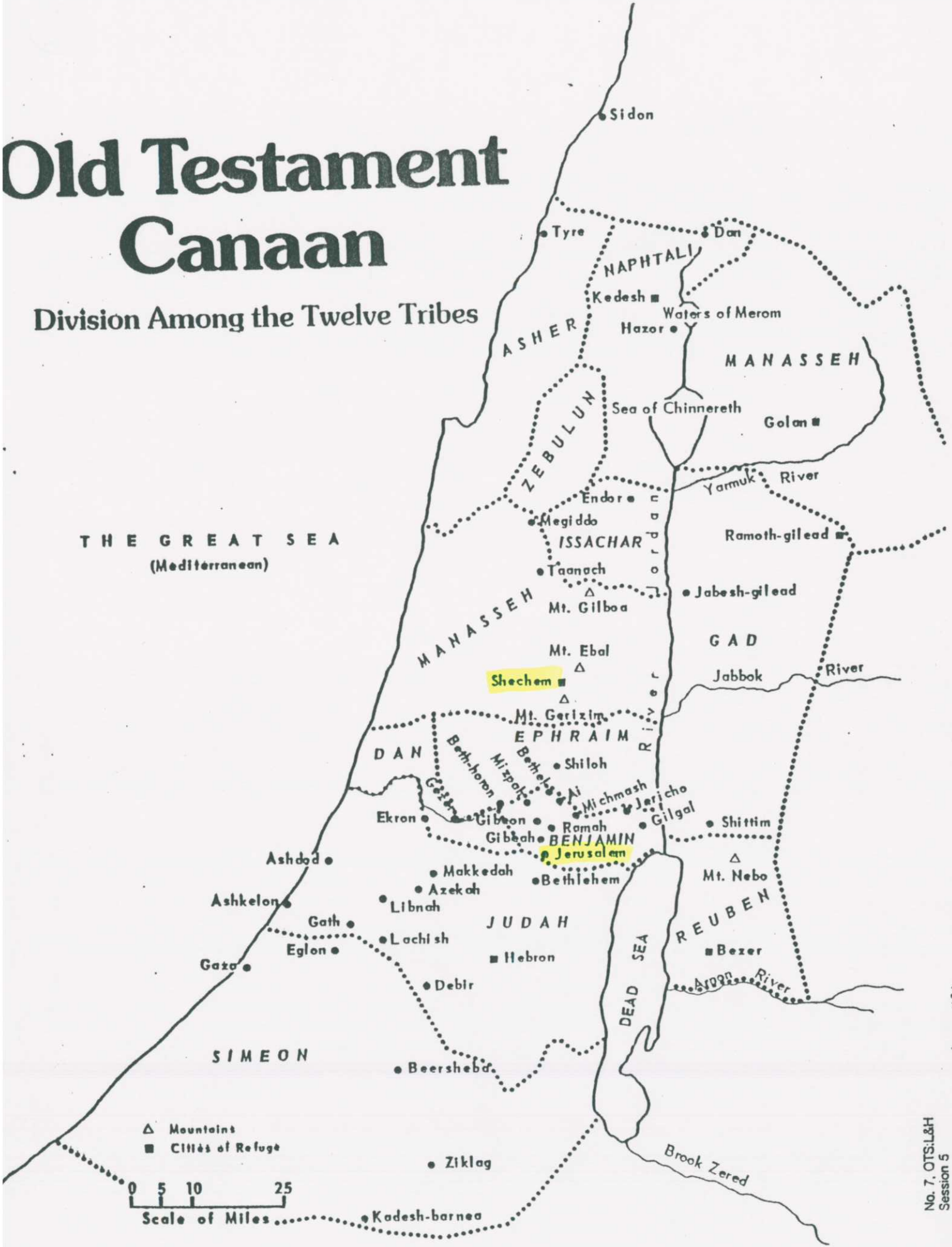


△ Mountains
